Can I use Child Care?

Yes, all families can use childcare whether you are working or not.

Non-working families can use up to 24 hours per week.

Working families can use up to 50 hours per week.

How much does childcare cost?

Permanent Childcare rates are charged at per child per session (No hourly rates apply).

\$6.07 - \$23.00 per child for Before Care and

\$5.10 - \$26.50 per child for After Care.

Casual Bookings will cost an extra \$4.00 per child per session.

Will my Centrelink payments be affected?

No. All families that have children at this school can use this Accredited Childcare Service. Whether you are/ or not entitled to unemployment benefits. Every non-working family can use up to 24 hours per week (and still receive your Centrelink Payments). This will not effect your parenting payment.

How do I register to use Care?

You will need to complete an Enrolment Form for each child. Enrolments Forms are available in English and Chaldean, and pay a once a year fee of \$20.00 per Child. Enrolment forms can be collected from the school office, or families can collect a Enrolment form from or service located in the school Hall. Enrolment forms can also be printed from the School Website.

If I'm studying do I still have to pay?

Yes, you will still have to pay a small fee for BSC and ASC. You can apply to Centrelink for a special assistance payment called Jets. This is government funding to help families further their education and training while your child is booked into Before/After School Care

What are the hours of Before School Care and After School Care?

(BSC) - Before School Care 6.30am - 8.30am

(ASC) - After School Care 3.15pm - 6.15pm

Are meals provided while at Care?

Yes, we provide nutritious meals. During Before School Care (BSC) our service provides: Toast, Crumpets, Pikelets & Cereals. During After School Care (ASC) our service provides: a light meal with fresh fruit and vegetable platter daily.

Do Childcare Educators help my child with homework?

Yes, our qualified Educators will assist your child to complete their homework.

Does the OSHC Program operate throughout the School Holidays?

Good Samaritan Care OSHC does not operate during school holidays, but all our qualified Educators work at IN OUR LADYS CARE VACATION CARE PROGRAM located at Our Lady's Primary School. Both OSHC programs are owned by Father Varghese Kurisingal and operated through Our Lady's Parish. Mrs Margaret Mangone manages both services.

What can my child do whilst in care? *Our program is planned based on children's ideas, feedback and interests. Daily Activities include: Arts and Crafts, Indoor & Outdoor Sports, Colouring ins, Wii and Ipad provided, various Educational resources are available and Board Games.*
