Return to School

Following the Premier's announcement earlier today, I am pleased to confirm that we can return to our usual school routine tomorrow (Thursday).

To ensure that we continue to be safe and stay safe it is important that we all follow the Victorian Government's community restrictions:

1. Face masks must be worn while on school grounds - both indoors and outdoors.
2. There are limits in place as to how many visitors can be in the school at any given time. Signs are in place throughout the school to show the number of people allowed in a space at any one time.
3. Stay away if you are unwell - no matter how mild your symptoms - and get tested.
